The couple moved to Ellerslie Village in 2018 after their Epsom building was sold. "Leesa and I have definitely found our calling which is helping people," says Stephen. "Our son, Charlton runs our other business creating headstones on granite – which means we can assist our families with memorials."

Another important person in the business is Sue, their Chinese Funeral Director who speaks both Cantonese and Mandarin.

Leesa says she loves being part of the Ellerslie community and supporting local businesses, "We will often send people over to Union Post for drinks and a meal to send off a loved one, we buy all our ribbons and tissues from Zoey at Dollar House, and Kerry at Flowers of St John does some beautiful arrangements for us, I've even picked up some lovely vintage pieces from the SPCA Op-Shop for the cottage," she says.

### MEET GREG FLEMING, MP for Maungakiekie

#### GREG MIGHT BE NEW TO THE SEAT OF MAUNGAKIEKIE, BUT HE'S BEEN PART OF OUR COMMUNITY FOR TWENTY-SIX YEARS AND THIS IS CERTAINLY NOT HIS FIRST FORAY INTO PUBLIC SERVICE.

Greg's first role in the public charitable space was at the Parenting Place in 1998 when in its founding years. He later spent five years as CEO leading the development of a number of programmes to support families. Since then he's worked with, and for, a dozen different charities in areas such as youth development and rehabilitation, education and social justice.

"Two of the projects I'm most proud of are Te Whakaora Tangata at Manurewa Marae which helps whānau find freedom from intergenerational poverty, and most recently, Te Wānanga Ihorangi, which offers Te Reo Māori immersion tertiary programmes," he says.

Six months into the role Greg has been focussed on understanding the issues facing schools, businesses and the wider community.

He is currently helping Ellerslie School and Stanhope Road School navigate building projects with the Ministry of Education. His team is working with Auckland Transport to have turnstiles installed at Ellerslie Train Station as a deterrent after realising that when trains aren't running, crime drops.

He's also been collating feedback around intensity housing and the inattention of infrastructure, and is in conversations with Fletcher Building and other stakeholders around The Hill development.

"I want to do things and fix things this afternoon, but hopefully I get to be the local MP for a while – the best contribution I can make is to understand the issues really well and put some long term plans in place," he says.




